

Vista Toweling and Wovens

Bella Boxes

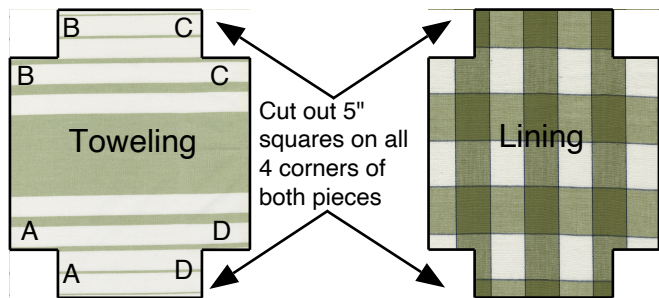
Finished Size:
6 1/2" x 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

- Requirements**
- 1/2yd (50cm) of 18" wide toweling
 - 1/2yd (50cm) lining fabric
 - 1/2yd (50cm) lightweight fusible interfacing
 - 1/2yd (50cm) lightweight fusible batting



- Cutting**
- * Toweling - cut 15" length and trim off hems. Should measure approx 17" wide x 15" long.
 - * Cut lining, interfacing and batting the same size as the toweling - 15" x 17".

- Preparation**
1. Fuse interfacing to the wrong side of the lining.
 2. Fuse batting to the wrong side of the toweling.
 3. Cut a 5" square from each corner of both rectangles.



- Completing the Bella Boxes**
1. Fold the corners, right sides together, so the A sides meet. Stitch down with a 1/4" seam. I recommend using a walking foot.
 2. Repeat for the B, C and D sides, on both the toweling and the lining.
 3. Turn the toweling box right sides out and place inside the lining so they are right sides together.
 4. Sew around the top edges of the box, leaving a 4" gap for turning through.
 5. Turn right sides out. Press the top edges.
 6. Sew around the top edge, very close to the edge, sewing up the opening as you go.
 7. Press the corners well. Pinch the vertical corners, lining sides together and sew down all the corners through all the fabric layers. See diagram. Make more for your friends.
